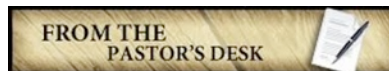

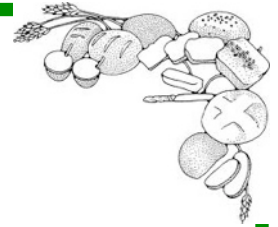

 ➤ to register for required class
 ➤ to finish necessary paperwork
 One of the godparents:
 ➤ must be baptized & confirmed
 ➤ a practicing Catholic who is sixteen years of age or older
