PRIOR TO SETTING A DATE FOR BAPTISM:

- Call the parish office at 897-7797:
 - to complete Registry paperwork
 - to register for required prep class

ONE OF THE GODPARENTS:

- must be baptized & confirmed
- a practicing Catholic who is sixteen years of age or older

PARISHIONERS WHO ARE facing surgery, struggling with serious illness or preparing for death may request this sacrament at any time

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE
