# **Ordained Deacons & Marriage**

May married men be ordained deacons? Degcons Yes. The Second Vatican Council To Serve decreed that the diaconate,

when it was restored as a permanent order in the hierarchy, could be opened to "mature married men, "later clarified to mean men over the age of 35. This is in keeping with the ancient tradition of the Church, in which married men were ordained into ministry. Also in keeping with ancient practice is the expectation that while a married man may be ordained, an ordained man, if his wife should die, may not marry again without special permission.
