- Prisca and her husband Aquila were close friends and supporters of Paul, and as such were founding members of the Christian Church. Paul's letters record their long friendship, from first meeting to the bitter farewell not long before his execution.
- Prisca seems to have been the dominant partner in the marriage. She was strongminded, fervent in her love for God and Jesus Christ, loyal to her husband- and something of a mover and shaker.
- She was trusted by Paul to manage the infant church he left behind, and she taught the gospel as Paul had done. Neither of them had met Jesus of Nazareth, but their faith was strong.

 Without them to teach and organize, the church might not have blossomed as soon as it did.
