The meeting was called to order by the President – Rosemarie Adams at 9:40 with approximately 20 women in attendance.

The opening prayer was presented by Chris Keating – the focus of the prayer and readings “on Our Lady of Fatima LENT – Offer it up.” “Our Lady said “*Make sacrifices for sinners, and say often, especially while making a sacrifice: **O Jesus, this is for love of thee, for the conversion of sinners, and in reparation for offenses committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary.**”*” Following the prayer the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Rosemarie Adams.

Our first guest speaker – Sharron Dooley was introduced by Dee Purka. Donated items can be left in the NARTHEX near the Eucharistic Adoration sign-up table. Donations need to be provided NLT April 8th.... **REMEMBER** - April 9th, NOON, in the COR parish hall. Pails will be put together to be delivered on April 10th. Thank you for your donations toward this Easter endeavor.

Our next guest speakers were Allie Noah – Development Director and Shelia Campbell from The Children’s Neighborhood **Children in Crisis, Inc.** The facility (located in FWB) has an emergency shelter for children who are removed without notice from an unsafe environment, and family foster homes for young children. This Children’s Neighborhood helps with the severe shortage of foster homes in our community. Before CIC, there were no emergency shelter homes in Circuit 1. Without CIC many foster children would be moved from home to home-some as many as ten times per year. **BUT** the Children’s Neighborhood provides a home and hope to about 100 children each year. Last year you wonderful ladies generously donated either gift cards from Wal-Mart, Target or Kohls **OR** cash/checks toward **EASTER OUTFITS** for the children. The house parents take the children shopping and **YES** the children do attend church services on Easter Sunday. Thank you **AGAIN** for your generosity this year. If you were not at the meeting on March 3rd...it’s not too late. Easter isn’t until April 16th thus there is still time to
