The purpose of this day is to publicly fulfill the Lord's instruction to:

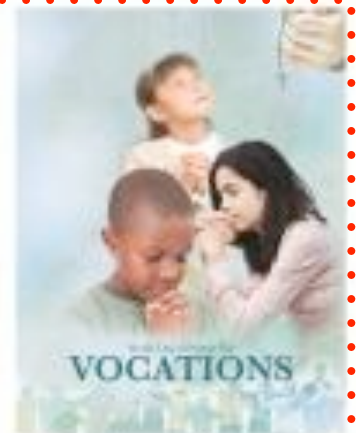
"Pray the Lord of the harvest to send laborers into his harvest" (Lk 10:2)

SACRAMENT OF THE SICK

Anointing
Request by calling the Parish Office
Parishioners who are facing surgery or struggling with serious illness may request this sacrament from Father Bob at any time.



SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Call the Parish Office to schedule an appointment with the pastor before setting a Wedding Date.
➤ Arrangements must be made SIX MONTHS in ADVANCE of anticipated Wedding Date.
➤ Registration for & the completion of marriage preparation program are required to be married by a Catholic priest.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Prior to setting a Baptism date for your child, please call the parish office at 897-7797:
➤ to register for required class
➤ to complete necessary paperwork
One of the godparents:
➤ must be baptized
➤ confirmed &
➤ a practicing Catholic who is sixteen years of age or older
