**NO SUMMER STORY TIME ~ THURSDAY: JULY 2<sup>ND</sup>**

**EDUCATE ... ENLIGHTEN ... INFORM ...**

**ON JULY 1<sup>ST</sup>** -- we honor the life of the **Blessed Junipero Serra**, a Spanish Franciscan friar who founded several missions in California in the 18<sup>th</sup> century. The first mission he founded was San Diego in 1769 followed by Monterey/Carmel in 1770; San Antonio and San Gabriel in 1771; San Luis Obispo in 1772 and in 1776 San Juan Capistrano and San Francisco plus Santa Clara in 1777 and San Buenaventura in 1782.

**After his canonization** at the "Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception" in Washington, DC, by Pope Francis on September 23<sup>rd</sup>, he will be **Saint Junipero**. Blessed Junipero Serra is being canonized "because he was holy, not because he was perfect."

**He was totally devoted** to evangelizing, educating and administering the sacraments and sharing his love of God with the Native Americans, whom he deeply loved and they loved him in return" in what is now the state of California.

**SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE**

**Before setting a Wedding Date:**  
 Call parish office at 897-7797:  
 ➤ Schedule appointment with Pastor **SIX MONTHS in ADVANCE** of anticipated Wedding Date  
 ➤ To be married in Catholic Church by a Catholic priest **registration & completion** of prep program required

**SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM**

**Prior to setting a Baptism date:**  
 Call the parish office at 897-7797:  
 ➤ to register for required class  
 ➤ to finish necessary paperwork  
 One of the godparents:  
 ➤ must be baptized & confirmed  
 ➤ a practicing Catholic who is sixteen years of age or older
