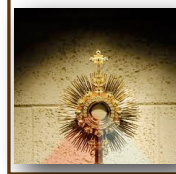

AGNES GONXHA BOJAXHIU, the nun known to the world as Mother Teresa of Calcutta, was born in Macedonia in 1910. A Sister of Loreto, she taught girls in her order's mission schools in India for twenty years. However, on a train journey in the mountains in 1946, Sister Teresa suddenly realized that God was calling her to something more -- to care for the poorest of the poor.

Other young women, some her former students, joined Mother Teresa working with the sick, poor, and forgotten of Calcutta's slums. These women formed a new, worldwide order of nuns, the *Missionaries of Charity*. Like Mother Teresa, they wear a plain white, blue-edged sari, the traditional dress of Indian women. The women live a simple, prayerful life, taking care of people wherever there is a need.

The Nobel Peace Prize was awarded to Mother Teresa and she used the prize money to found new homes and hospitals for the poor. God called Mother Teresa home in 1997. Her life and work remind us that happiness and holiness come from doing "*something beautiful for God.*" Beatified in 2003, she will be canonized Sunday, Sept 4th. Copyright (c) J. S.
