Our altar servers are among the best in the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee. Several servers have been chosen to compete at the state level for the Knights of Columbus Altar Server of the Year Award.

As your pastor I revel in the many accolades received about our altar servers. It is my wish that this program remain strong and our servers remain, if you will, the cream of the crop – the best of the best. Formal training is necessary to continue quality service for Our Lord in His House. We are very blessed with an excellent training program under the collaborative efforts of Deacon Jim Murray, Deacon Miguel Nolla, Acolyte Thomas Toltzien and our parent team, Adam and Sarah Dieterich.

Each altar server is required to attend one formal training session a year. I highly encourage parents to attend the training session with your child. This will help you understand what your child is responsible for as he or she serves in our liturgies. The intent of the training is so each server will become an individual thinker and be able to perform his or her duties with little or no immediate direction or supervision.

Attendance is required at only one session during the school year (although, your child is welcome to attend more than one, if he or she so desires). The sessions are on a Saturday from 9:00 a.m. until 12 noon. At the end of each training session a pizza lunch is served. We have three training dates on the parish master calendar:

Saturday - December 9, 2017

Saturday - February 17, 2018

Saturday - May 12, 2018

I pray you will see the benefit of this program and be an advocate of this training with your child. I also ask that you R.S.V.P. so we can plan for training materials and pizza.
